SIXTH WEEK OF EASTERTIDE

From Father Anthony

It seemed ages since I had sat outside, tea in hand, letting the early morning wash me awake. The gunslinger flitted over and challenged me. A spiv, all white, blue and black, strutted across the lawn and darted for something. The apple tree shook her hair of white blossom and let it cascade to the ground. I breathed deeply. I took in the slate grey sky. It was still with an opening far over to the right. Through it hazy clouds simmered in sunlight, piled high like mountains receding into the distance. I felt drawn to them and comforted, as if a friend were with me.

I will not leave you orphans. Life, if we are honest, can seem lonely at times. Even in the closest relationships we experience the reality of our individuality, our aloneness, whether we are a good, bad or indifferent person. Many of us run away from feelings of aloneness: we cram our lives with as many distractions as possible; anything, to get away from the sense of aloneness or individuality... and then berate ourselves for the addictions and depressions these distractions bring. It can become a vicious circle. But, we have not, in fact, been left alone.

We have prayer; not the I speak, you listen type of prayer; more, the you speak, I listen type. His voice is best heard in the deepest silence: so much so, that we might not even believe we have heard it! But its effects will be there because there is a person at the other end of Prayer. The Gospel refers to this person as the Advocate. The word used is παράκλητος, paraklétos (paraclete): it means someone who is close beside us, who can, like a lawyer, make the right judgement call for us. When we are lonely or confused, adrift at sea in a fog without a rudder, there is He who can point out the best direction, comforting us with His silent voice and assisting us to make life judgments that will bring us peace. Prayer is one place to experience this Paraclete.

Confession is another place. In this Sacrament we can pour out the effects of aloneness... not to be admonished but to hear, through the words of the priest, the loving, understanding, forgiving (reconciling) words of the Paraclete. To know that whatever we have thought, said or done we are not alone... nor condemned.

Month of May - during May we will be singing the Salve Regina after each of the weekday Masses in honour of our Lady.
