## OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST KING OF THE UNIVERSE

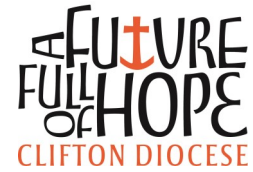
### From Father Anthony

It had been another one of those days! Frazzled, distracted and tired I went outside to take stock. Traffic rumbled: a helicopter whumped the air. Freshly barbered, the garden reflected my desire to be shorn of unwanted, tiresome, self-preoccupied, thoughts. The sun slid westwards: a fresh breeze swirled leaves and tickled my neck. As always, nature, and the Brown Sparrows taking a bath, helped me separate from my interior darkness and find a smile.

“When the Son of Man comes in his glory”, also refers to an interior quality: the Christ or Divine Mind fully alive within us. This mind is formed by living out the great commandment, “you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind and your neighbour as yourself”. We are hard wired to be self-absorbed or self-interested. This is necessary for survival: yet, to remain in it creates darkness within. The way out of this darkness, through prayer and spiritual practice, is to love God: to prefer what He prefers; to see the world and others as He sees them: to find Him in others and not as a projection of our imagination. The quality of His Mind expresses itself as love and compassion for others and a great desire for their wellbeing. This is the glorious throne. Being in a state of love and compassion we become love and compassion: just as when you are angry you are the first person to experience that anger, so, when you love you are the first to experience it... you love yourself as you love your neighbour.

From this glorious throne, in the light of our love and compassion we summon the nations before us. These nations are the thoughts and emotions we can control. We discern the difference between the receptive, obedient, productive and the aggressive, disobedient, destructive: the innately good and those spoilt by selfish motives: sheep and goats. The unselfish we allow to grow, the selfish we gently discard.

At the end of the church’s year perhaps we should take stock and find out if Christ is King within. If not: if our thoughts are predominantly selfish... thank God! Taking stock is not an exercise in self-recrimination: it is to gain clear sight and understanding. Knowing that we are selfish is the first positive step towards correcting it!

## OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

On the last Sunday of each liturgical year, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, or Christ the King. Pope Pius XI instituted this feast in 1925 with his encyclical *Quas primas* ("In the first") to respond to growing secularism and atheism. He recognized that attempting to "thrust Jesus Christ and his holy law" out of public life would result in continuing discord among people and nations.
