ADVENT WEEK 2 (B)

From Father Anthony

It was a steel grey day with strong winds and heavy rain: no sitting outside with a cup of tea. I sat before the one-eyed god, tapping away, occasionally glancing out of the window. With ruffled feathers the gangsters attempted, 'into the wind spot landings': neither the gunslinger nor the brown sparrows were anywhere to be seen. Feeling my tummy rumble I went into the kitchen to prepare a morsel or two for lunch. 'Prior preparation and planning', we used to say, 'prevents, poor performance' (polite version). Properly prepared, the tomato sauce, timely cooked pasta, Parmigiano Reggiano and a few lettuce leaves were lovely.

"Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths." Prepare: another Advent word. It comes from the Latin praeparare, meaning 'to make ready beforehand', (A study of the Hebrew word Kun bis interesting too). During Advent we prepare to recognise Christ within as well as historical remembrance.

Interior preparation includes *staying awake* - we spoke of this last week - principally by being aware of our thoughts, feeling and actions. Perseverance in *awareness* will reveal how our lives need to change... often accompanied by the thought *'there must be a better way'*. We come to realise how limited, stereotyped and erroneous our thoughts, feelings and understandings are about God and Creation.

The Gospel urges us to go deep within (wilderness): clear out old thoughts, habits and actions (baptism): renewing them with thoughts based in love and recognition of Christ within (repentance). Awareness of and clearing out the old is preparation for recognition of Christ in and as our own deeper consciousness. This is the direct (straight) path to God. We find ourselves 'dressed in camels' hair with a leather girdle about our loins, living on locusts and wild honey'. This is a spiritual description of our true nature freed from the darkness of duplicitousness, error, envy, self-absorption and hate: now revealed as clear, strong, truthful, vibrant and loving; living spontaneously on what the world has to offer. Discarding the old person, (baptism in water), we recognise Christ within and become a new, (baptism in the Holy Spirit). We now think, feel and act in and as Christ; seeing Him in everyone.

If we want this, to awareness we must add prayer. Find a place and set a time every day during Advent; and in that place, for perhaps five minutes, pray for renewal within.
